



Firefly Image gallery plugin

Firefly Image gallery

With the firefly image gallery it is easy to create an image gallery from the images inside a specific folder in any article.

After installing the plugin, the plugin is ready to use.

How to use the firefly image gallery plugin

Inside any article just type `{fireflyimagegallery images/folder}` where the folder contains the images that need to be shown.

Setup Parameters

There are a few parameters that can be adjusted: the number of images next to each other and the size in pixels.

This can be found in **Plugins->Firefly imagegallery**

columns

Size (px)

columns is to setup the number of images next to each other.

Size (px) is to setup the size of a thumbnail, measured in pixels.

How is the plugin working

The plugin contains 4 steps:

1. Creates a folder "*thumbnails*" in the image folder that was entered in the plugin call. If the folder already exists, it doesn't create the thumbnail folder.
2. Check if the current thumbnail size is the correct size. The plugin checks if the first thumbnail image had the size that was given by the plugin parameters. If they are not the same, a resize procedure will start,. If there are no difference then there will be no action for resizing.
- 3.If there are more thumbnails then normal images, the plugin is checking which thumbnail has no large image and is removing that thumbnail.
- 4.If there are more large images then thumbnails, the plugin is checking which large image is going to be resized.

By working this way all the images will stay up-to-date.
